Permit will be valid, only when all requirements have been met and are maintained. Only Michigan approved fireworks are allowed for sale. At no times are any live demonstrations of fireworks allowed. Must follow NFPA # 1123, #1124, & #1125 for regulations regarding the storage and selling of fireworks. The structure must be of a flame retardant covering, with an ample amount of working fire extinguishers on location with all employees trained in usage, as per the Michigan Fire Marshall ruling. Must include accurate contact information for after hours for the fire chief. Must be able to totally secure the structure during closed hours. Note: that by accepting this permit the sales vender acknowledges that at any time the City of Caro, fire chief, and or any police officer has the right to close down the sales at any time for any reason. For permit to be granted and allowed all required paperwork must accompany this application.

Fireworks Safety

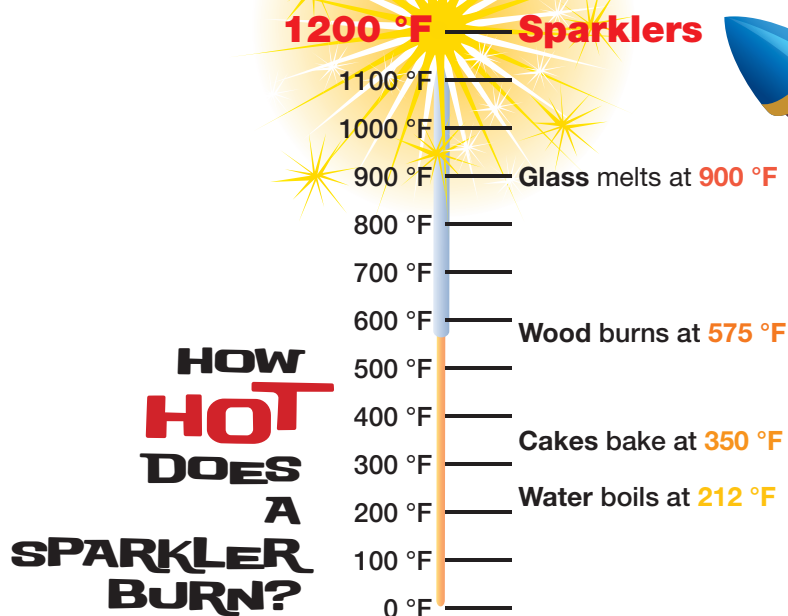
Fireworks are often used to mark special events and holidays. However, they are not safe in the hands of consumers. Fireworks cause thousands of injuries each year. People can enjoy fireworks safely if they follow a few simple safety tips:

BE CAREFUL!

- Be safe. If you want to see fireworks, go to a public show put on by experts.
- Do not use consumer fireworks.
- Keep a close eye on children at events where fireworks are used.

CONSUMER FIREWORKS

NFPA is opposed to consumer use of fireworks. This includes sparklers and firecrackers. Even sparklers burn hot enough to cause third-degree burns.



FACTS

- ! More than 16,000 reported fires are started by fireworks annually.
- ! Sparklers account for roughly one-quarter of emergency room fireworks injuries.
